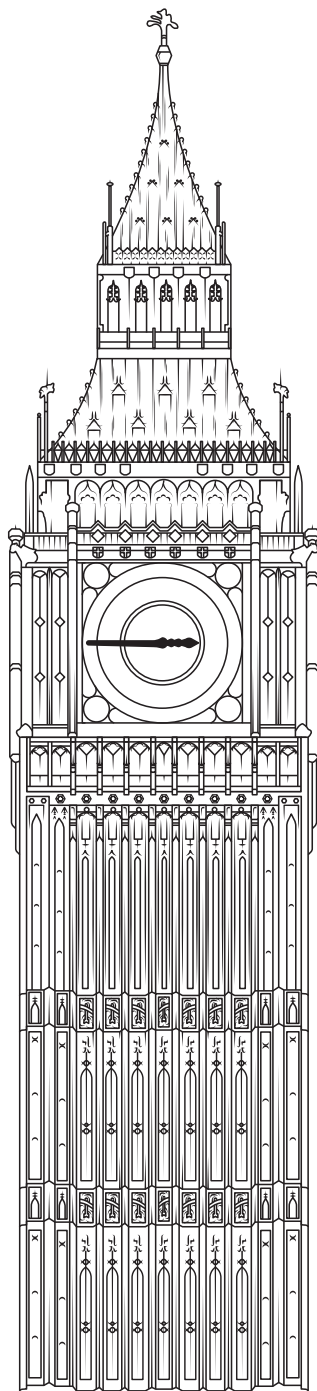


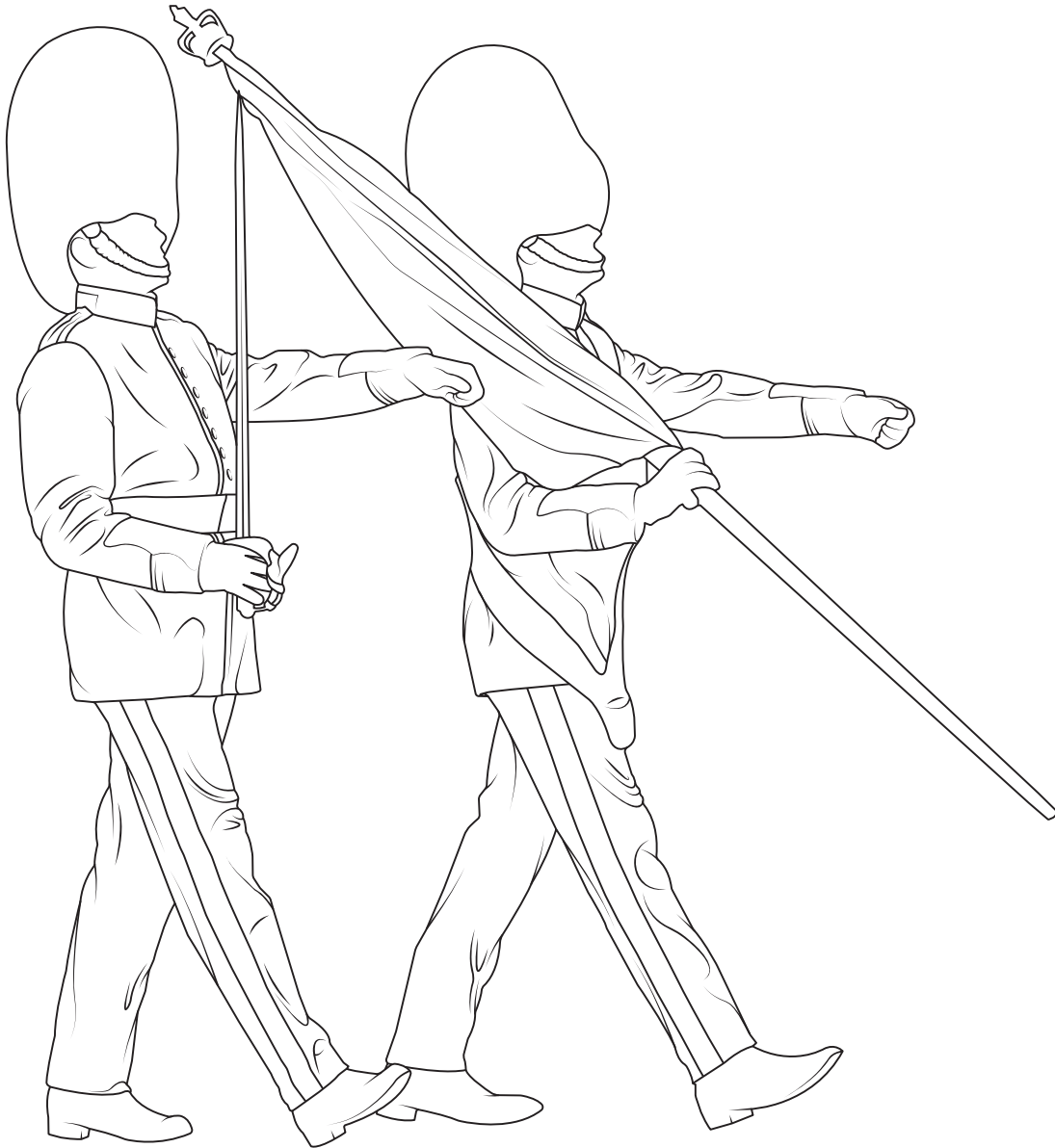
Phone Box

The Kiosk No. 6 or K6 for short, was designed in 1935 by British designer and architect Sir Giles Gilbert Scott. Although it is the most famous phone box design, this is actually the sixth version of the phone box to hit our streets (hence its name!).



The Clock Tower

That's right! This famous London landmark isn't officially named Big Ben. The name "Big Ben" came from Sir Benjamin Hall, who was the first commissioner of Public Works in London who was in charge of the construction of the Houses of Parliament, the building to which the tower is attached to.



### The Queen's Guardsman

The origin of these furry helmets dates back to the 18th Century. At the time, the gunner in British armies wore these enormous bearskin caps to make them appear taller. This was believed to intimidate their opponents. In addition, these massive bearskin caps can weigh up to 1.5 pounds.
